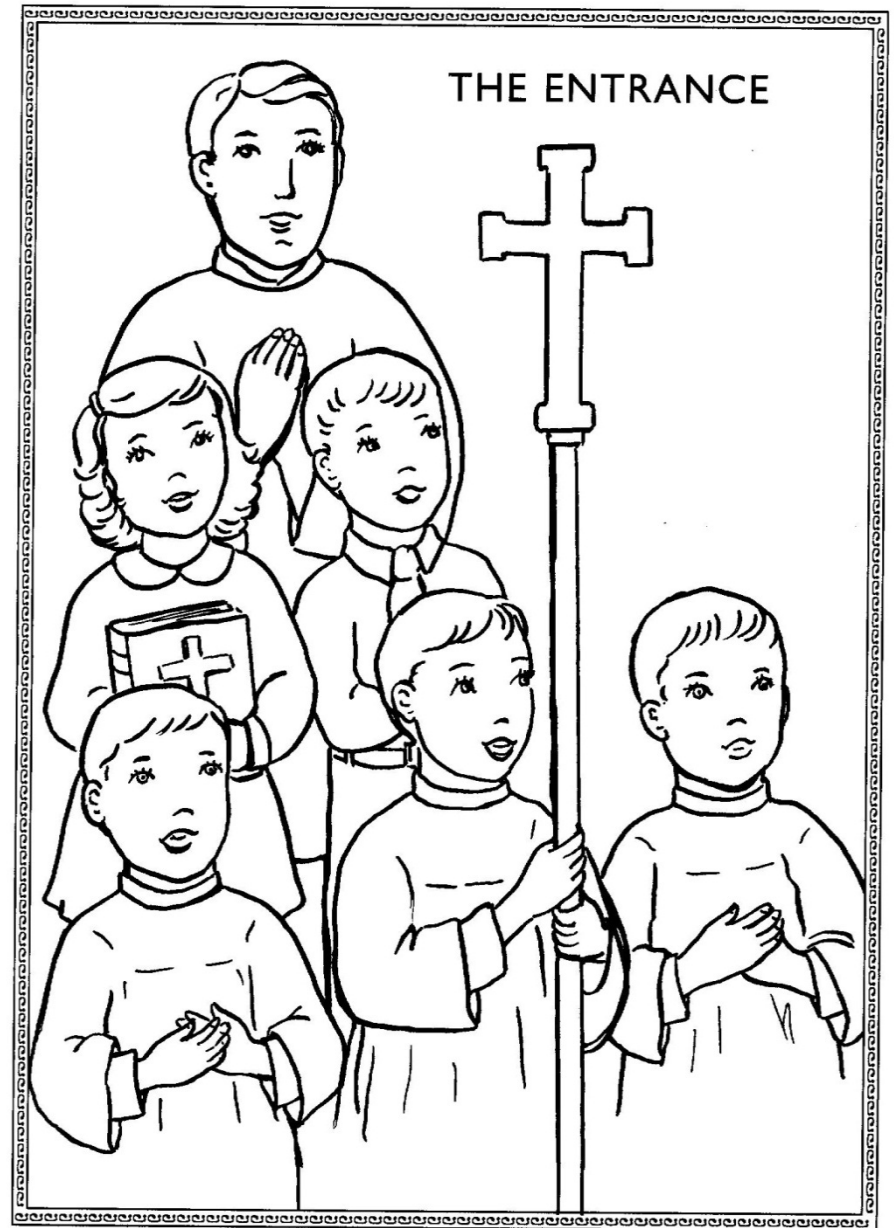
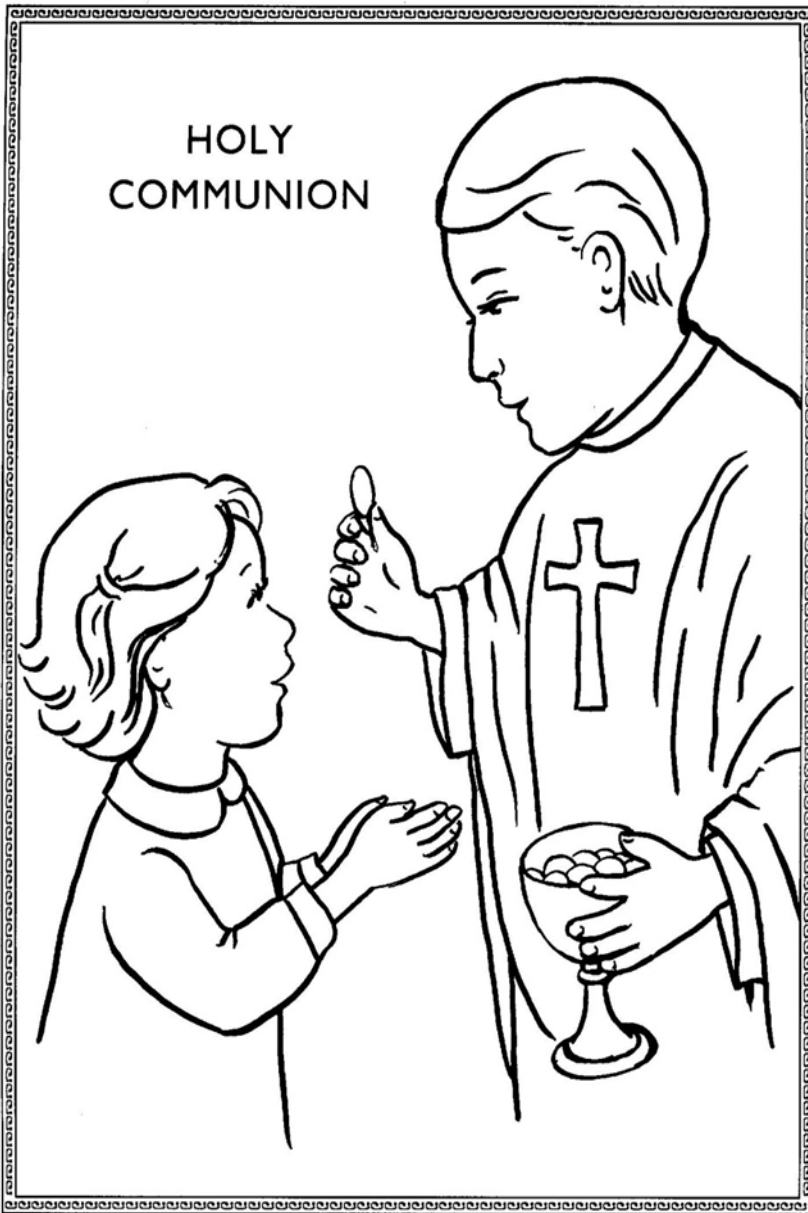


We conclude in song, and then go forth into the world to carry the love of Jesus to everyone we meet.



As the Priest and ministers approach the altar, we sing the Entrance Chant, which begins the celebration of Mass.



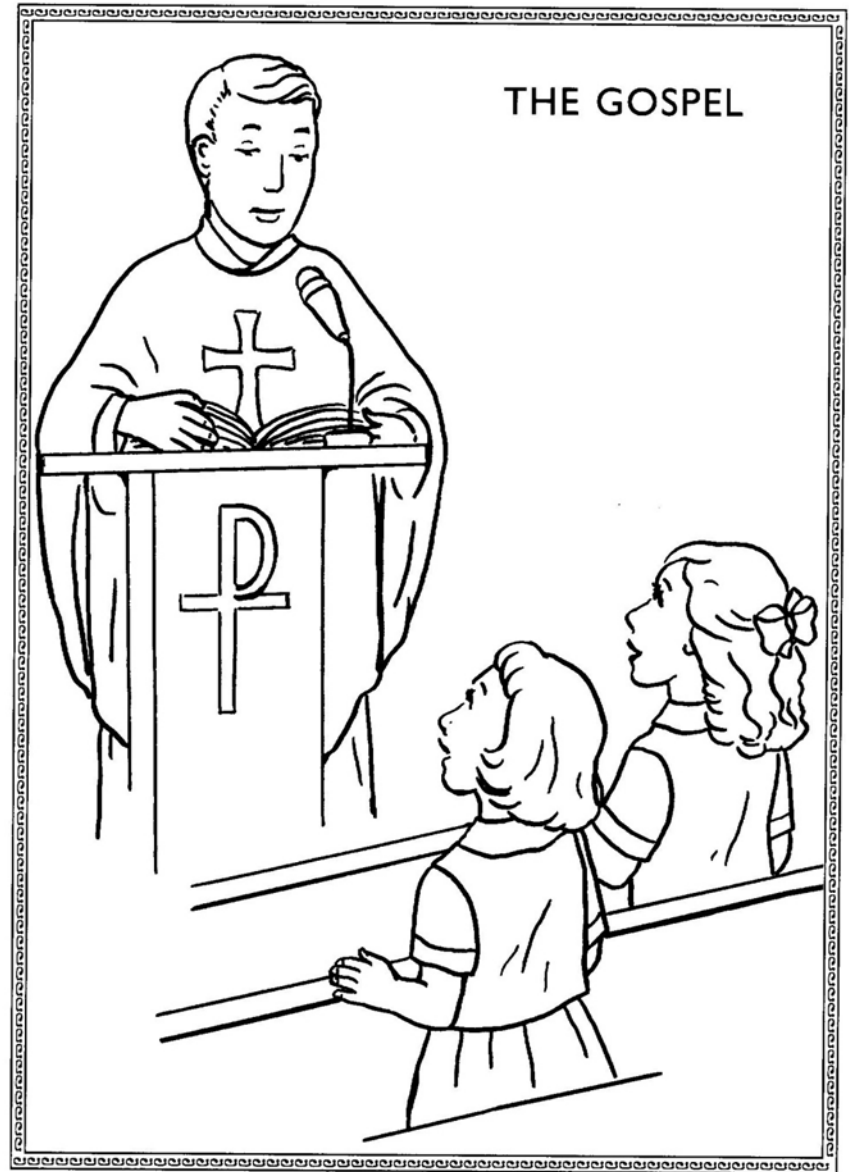
As the Priest, Deacon, or Extraordinary Minister gives us the host, we express our belief that we are receiving Jesus the Lord.



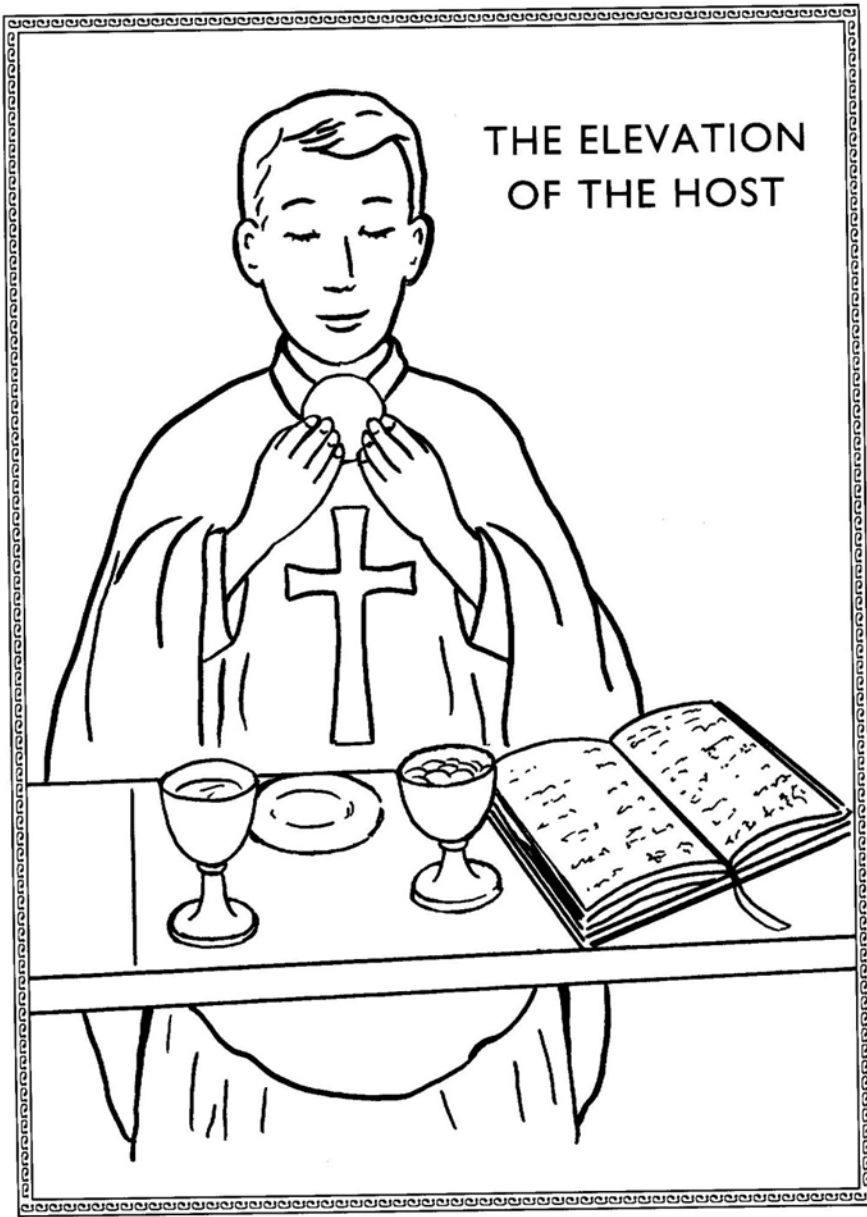
The Priest prays in the name of all who are present at Mass. He asks God for the graces we need.



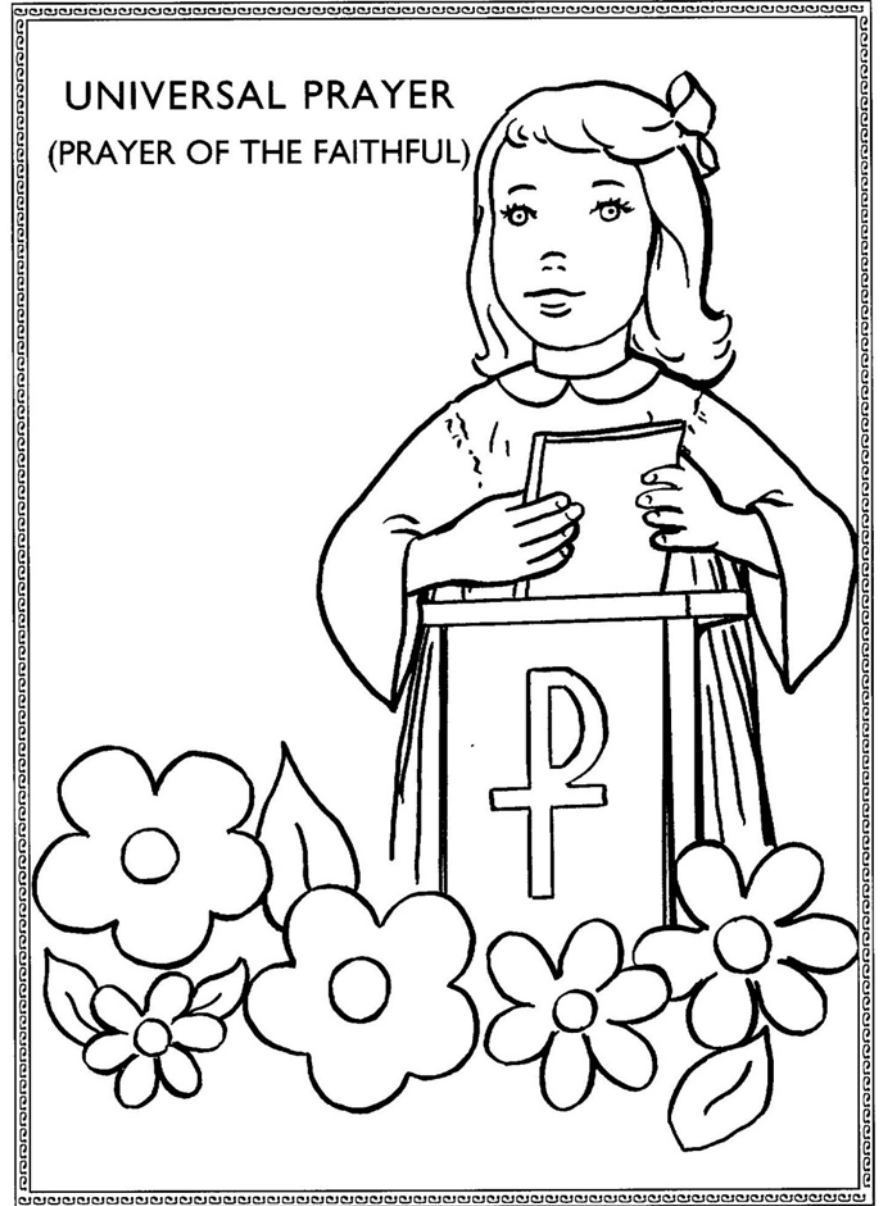
Before we receive the Body and Blood of Jesus, the Priest invites us to offer a sign of peace to one another.
